Who?

Community Justice Glasgow was formed to deliver the new arrangements of the Community Justice (Scotland) Act 2016. Our work is guided by the the Community Justice Outcomes Improvement Plan started in April 2017, running through until March 2018. The plan will be reviewed in December 2017 to align with the Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Local Outcomes Improvement Plan.

What we do?

The Community Justice (Scotland) Act 2016 changed local community justice arrangements. In Glasgow, we have built upon the work of previous arrangements by the Glasgow Community Justice Authority, which helped levels of reoffending in Glasgow.

How we do it?

We will achieve our outcomes by working with partners throughout Glasgow. With partners, a plan was created on themes for Community Justice Glasgow to focus on: women, families, victims, throughcare, building protective factors, communication, prevention, service & resource alignment and service user voice. An action plan explains the ways in which this will be achieved.



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
